They are always looking for personal hygiene (shampoo, soap, razors, toothbrushes, etc) and cleaning supplies, as well as paper goods (toilet paper, paper towels, tissue paper). You can drop everything off whenever you are at the lodge in the box near the ATM machine and I will deliver everything to Feed Lake Highlands. GOOD OF THE ORDER

Greetings my Brothers and Sisters, I welcome you tonight to this 4911 meeting of the Dallas Lodge #71 of the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks. Prosper us in this labor of love. Whether this is your first, tenth, hundredth or in the case of some of our older members 5000th meeting, thank you for coming tonight and I charge you to make it a habit and to remind others to come as well.

The business of the lodge is conducted here in this hall at these meetings. Before the internet, emails, texts or even phones this was the place to learn our goals, successes, share our joys and sometimes of our sadness. Morning and noon may pass but we are a lodge are linked to each and every other lodge bound by the same exact rituals and goals. Thousands of lodges have been created and hundreds have passed away, but here we stand tonight, a beacon to our community, our state and our country. The Order of Elks is distinctively American. Linking the destiny of our Order with the destiny of our country we have made its Flag the symbol of the crowning virtue. We created Flag Day, and the first time our ritual was performed was right here in Dallas, at the Grand Lodge Reunion in 1908, and later recognized by Woodrow Wilson and finally Harry Truman. We created the first veteran's hospital and service in 1917 and passed those resources along to the government.

But what are Elks? As we just so recently heard we are American citizens who guide our course in life by the cardinal principles of our Order: Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity. These principles as well as the charges in our obligation must be nurtured not only in this room, but throughout the course of our daily lives as a constant guide and faithful monitor.

I spoke with a long time Elk at an event about always being here and seeing the same people. They said that they tended to hang out with the same people outside of the walls as well as inside, so it wasn't a chore. A new grandchild has cut back on that time, but they are still here often and always with a smile and an open heart.

We host a myriad of charitable events, most of which are also incredibly social. I ask that each of you try and make time as you are able: to assist, attend and support. Do you have to "live here", certainly not. However, I strongly encourage you to make time to get to know your fellow Elks, find common interests inside and outside the lodge. The most powerful bonds are formed through familiarly and teamwork. Sometimes the food isn't five stars, (but it's usually good) and the weather outside not pool worthy, but I guarantee the fellowship inside can be!

There are numerous committees conducting the activities of the lodge, find one or two that align with your passions and become involved. Fill a red pig, work a night of bingo once a month, come to a dinner and support one of our programs, cook in the kitchen, or any number of other opportunities. Sweethearts, ENF, Veterans, Feed Lake Highlands, Bingo, Bridge, Karaoke, Dancing and even having a dip in the pool with a refreshing beverage but strive to become involved with your lodge. Attend meetings, learn about what we do, who we do it with, and why. Ask questions, make suggestions, vote vote vote. Exercise your right of franchise. Encourage others to do so, expand our principles outside of these walls.

We are Elks, let the people hear the pounding of our hooves each and every day.
